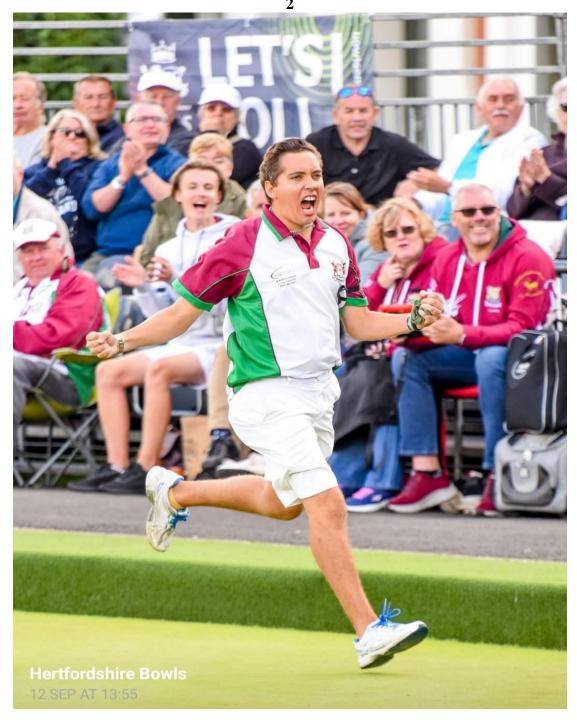
And of course thanks go to the Assistant Manager, Tony Keeling, his counsel and input has been invaluable and after a period of ill health it was great that he could be at Leamington.
