



DRESS CODE BYLAWS

For County Match Play:

Women:

- A). For attending Inter County and Presidents' matches the regulation dress shall be: White skirt, culottes, tailored trousers or tailored cropped trousers; County shirt and Dark Blue blazer unless player has a National Blazer. For Presidents' matches players who do not have a County or National Blazer may wear their club blazer/jacket.
For Match Play in All Matches shall be White skirt, culottes, tailored trousers, tailored cropped trousers or shorts, County shirt and either a County or white jacket (if worn), shoes of an approved pattern. Brown tights and stockings are optional. White ankle socks may be worn with trousers and only "Footsies" with culottes, cropped trousers and shorts.
- B).

Men:

- A). For attending Inter County and Presidents' matches the regulation dress shall be: grey tailored trousers, dark blue blazer unless the player has a National Blazer, white collared shirt and county tie. For Presidents' matches players who do not have a dark blue blazer or National blazer may wear their club blazer/jacket. Players may if they wish arrive dressed for match play, ie County shirt and white or grey trousers but must change into regulation dress with blazer, collar & tie for the meal and after match formalities
- B). For Match Play in All Matches shall be white tailored trousers or ~~Bowls England Regulation~~ shorts, County shirt with either County or white jacket (if worn), shoes of an approved pattern and if worn socks, belts and braces to be white.

For Competition Play: All Players

- A). All competitors shall wear grey below the waist with predominantly white tops and shoes of an approved pattern in all rounds up to semi-final stage. For semi-final and final stages of all competitions players shall wear predominantly white.
- B). Club coloured clothing and shorts of correct colour may be worn in all rounds.

General for both Match & Competition Play: All Players

- A). Sandals are not permitted in any match except in medical circumstances where a doctor's note has been provided.
- B). When Club apparel is worn all members of the side or team shall wear the same design provided it has been registered with the county.
- C). Players governed by requirements of a specific ethnic culture will be permitted to wear their traditional dress if they desire.
- D). Tracksuits, shell suits and jeans are not acceptable.
- E). Headgear, if worn, should be white or a registered colour.
- F). Socks, if visible, shall be white (grey if grey trousers are worn)
- G). Tights or stockings are optional at all times. If worn they must be in shades of brown.
- H). Waterproof clothing when worn shall be predominantly white or County colours for Match Play. For competitions waterproof clothing shall be mostly white or the Registered coloured waterproof clothing/fleeces.

Player Violation:

- A). Any player who contravenes these Dress Code Rules in competition play will be liable to disqualification from that competition if they are unable to comply with the Dress Code Rules at that time.
- B). Any player who contravenes these Dress Code Rules in County Match play will be liable to be substituted in that match if they are unable to comply with the Dress Code Rules at that time.
